Essential Functions:

- Management of bulk wine inventory for Reddy Vineyards estate wines and its clients, including monitoring and maintaining quality of wines consistent with production and storage protocols.
- Execute cellar work orders and processes for accuracy, completion, and compliance.
- Wine production as directed by the winemaking team.
- Perform lab analysis of grapes/wines from vineyard to bottle.
- Maintaining inventories of dry goods, storage vessels, lab chemicals, additives and other winemaking materials.
- Maintaining sanitation in winery and maintenance of winemaking equipment.
- Record management, including work orders and compliance information.
- Other relevant clerical and manual tasks as determined by the winemaking team.
- Oversee work of Cellar Associates and interns to ensure accuracy and completion of assigned tasks.
- Host in-winery tastings and represent the company at industry events (Brownfield; Lubbock) as required.

Qualifications

- Understanding of wine production, winemaking products, and production equipment.
- Prior experience in product production.
- Excellent written and oral communication skills.
- Strong organizational, problem-solving, and analytic skills; able to manage priorities and workflow.
